# PROMOTING BRITISH VALUES IN THE EYFS

The fundamental British values of democracy, rule of law, individual liberty, mutual respect and tolerance for those with different faiths and beliefs are already implicitly embedded in the 2014 Early Years Foundation Stage.

Here at Whitewell Bottom Pre-school staff will actively promote British values by:

### **Democratically making Decisions together:**

Staff encourage children to discuss and share views on creating a rich and varied learning environment. Also children contribute to our termly Role Play area by taking turns and listening to other children's ideas.

### **Understanding Rules matter:**

Staff encourage all children to be kind to one another and help to tidy up. The children are aware of the Pre-school rules and will often ask staff for a sticker to go on the "STAR OPF THE WEEK" board.

### **Understanding Individual Liberty:**

The key-person system is well established and effective. All children are emotionally secure and are able to develop positive relationships with adults and their friends. This promotes their high levels of confidence and self-esteem.

### **Having mutual respect and tolerance:**

We actively promote this by creating an ethos of inclusion and tolerance. Where views, faiths, cultures and races are valued. Our children are encouraged to be engaged within the wider community. We have visits from local emergency and public services, our local Vicar and other community group users.
